











**Skills, experience and knowledge Trustees must have.**

<p>1.</p>		<p>You are a Disabled person. When we say Disabled people we mean the full spectrum of health, impairment and difference. This includes people with mental illness, those with learning difficulties, people with physical, sensory or cognitive impairments, including those who experience Disability through the effects of ageing. It is important to stress that we welcome those who are D/deaf and people on the autistic spectrum or anyone else who may not identify as a Disabled person.</p>
